Rent Smart Education and Support Society (RSESS) believes in the transformative power of education to help individuals and families to find and maintain their housing, increase successful tenancies, and prevent housing instability and homelessness.

RSESS provides education and support to tenants, housing providers and community champions with one goal: *successful tenancies*. Successful tenancies are key to building strong communities, increasing housing stability and preventing homelessness.

Headquartered in Victoria, British Columbia, RSESS currently has over a thousand educators trained in every province and territory across Canada. RSESS has specific curriculum adapted for British Columbia, Alberta, Manitoba, Ontario and in 2022 we will be adding Saskatchewan and Nunavut.

Directors can serve two, three-year terms. There are generally six to eight board meetings per year with some additional working group meetings. The time commitment is not more than two hours per month. Board meetings are hosted online.
